**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Michael Holloran made a motion to approve the October minutes. Russ Brown seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

( ) District #21 Bus Loading/Unloading Zone on 10<sup>th</sup> Street

Dale McCabe reported he is still waiting to hear back from District #21 and because of the latest round of Covid closures, school is out of session, so realistically he is not expecting anything to happen any time soon. Will keep on the agenda until more talk occurs.

B) Rapid Flashing Beacon Discussion

Dale is still compiling a list of locations. Russ suggested a possible location on Lincoln between 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Streets. Members wondered what the City police records show for incidents at that location. Another suggestion was made for the RFB at 12th & Kelly Avenue. This would be in addition to the sidewalk bulb outs. Dale will add those suggestions to his list. Discussion will continue with December meeting.

C) Request for Additional Stop Sign on 20<sup>th</sup> (both sides of Radio Way)

City staff will check out area and get back with members in December.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

A) Request for 10 Minute drop off/Pick up Zone on Webber near the Gymnastic Building

Russ said he received a text from a citizen asking if a 10 minute loading/unloading zone could be established in the yellow area on Webber, near the Bargeway intersection. David and Dale will measure the width of the roads to see if there's room for a small drop off/pick up on Webber Road.

B) Miscellaneous


